Secretary's Report - J. Feeney

- ITS MI Meeting Minutes approved from December 2019
- Motion to approve, Minutes approved

President's Report – S. Verkest

• Jim Santilli will be taking over for Pat Cawley as a board member with TIA.

Treasurer's Report – K. McIntosh

- Kiel updated the board with the profit and loss and will balance out the bank account.
- Washtenaw Community College supported ITS Michigan with costs; this saved a lot of money that helped with any balance.

Legislative Update – P. Cawley

- There are competing Hands Free law bills one in the house and one in the senate (SB288). The house bill is sponsored by Rep. Manoogian and recently passed the house, it is supported by the Governor. It is not likely to pass the senate (Republican controlled). SB288 has been championed by Jim for years and has more teeth. They are working on combining with the house bill to get the needed language for enforcement. Outcome to be determined.
- Debby and Matt Smith will gather a statement and have any ITS MI sign it.
- Debby mentioned that there is a Michigan rep from District 10, he is on the T&I committee and they are signing a letter. Debby would not discourage anyone from sending letters to Dingell, Stabenow, Haley Stevens.
- Yousuf mentioned coordinating a breakfast for the local representatives and having a conversation with ITS Michigan.
- Kristina Kow at the University would be helpful with hosting that. The CCAT Global Symposium in April has a topic of inviting the local legislatures. Something in February would be preferable.



Nominating Committee - G. Piotrowicz

- Gary is working with Amanda Roraff to see if there is interest in joining the board.
- ITS Michigan welcomed Barb Land to the Board.
- All board members terms expire in May 2020.
- There are several seats still open, if anyone has nominations please let Gary know.

Regional Transportation Operations Committee – D. Beaubien

- The last Regional operations meeting had 26 people.
- Waycare arranged a 45-minute webinar for ITS Michigan a few weeks ago.
- Next coordinating committee meeting is scheduled for April 17, 2020.
- May 21st TIM Partnering Workshop Paul Ajegba, Director MDOT is on the program, also Country Sherriff, City of Ann Arbor, U of M, Fire Chief will do a panel on traffic. Dennis Neubacher, traffic reporter will be on the program.

Membership and Fundraising - D. Bezzina

- We need members that are not on the board to be part of the committees.

Emerging Leaders Program – Barb Land

• Barb is the Vice Chair of the Emerging Leaders Committee. There are 3 parts, a global competition for college students, Oakland University. The National program has SquareOne autonomous program to a national level with



high school students. ITS Michigan is sponsoring Roseville High school (double check), they are aiming for 25 teams to participate in this competition.

- May 20, 2020 Kettering University is the program. Judges are needed for this event.

- We could add what Michigan is doing to support.
- We could invest some scholarship money from ITS Michigan to the high schools, this can be revisited after the March bowling event.
- Global Symposium last year ITS Michigan donated \$1,000 1 Undergrad (\$500) 1 Grad (\$500).
- Need to reinvigorate the student chapter Debby spoke to their faculty advisor, a lot was done the first year, but need more activity this year. Debby will reach out to them.
- Wayne State and other universities could be more involved. Maybe a roadshow at other universities or a
 networking night to invite all the universities. ACM had previously had a talent fair similar to this, where ITS MI
 could coordinate with them on this possibly.

Program Coordinating Committee - D. Bezzina

- Yousuf has raised the bar and doubled the anticipated attendance.

- Maybe do a joint ITS Michigan/ITS Midwest annual meeting with Michigan being the center of the meeting and adding a technology demo, maybe in 2021 or 2022.
- Matt Klawon asked about annual sponsorships to be added in the budget that include free registrations as part of the sponsorship or as a partnership.
- The finance committee will have a meeting in February to discuss sponsorship options to bring to the board for the March meeting.



- Student chapters Barb would like to have a high school chapter that goes into the college ITS Michigan Student chapter. WCC having a student chapter is an option as well.
- Should ITS Michigan consider having booths set up and go to other states/conferences to attract additional talent to look at Michigan as well? Maybe choose one annual meeting each year.
